Any two weeks after you have successfully completed training between July – August.

How to Apply?

Step 1. Apply and Pay \$20

Come by to learn more about the L.I.T. program, drop off an application or participate in an interview. Call 780-944-7413 for more information. Interviews take about 15 minutes, with the total registration taking around a hour.

Step 2. Attend a Registration
