U of A Committee's West 240 Update

We recently received notice that UAPT has submitted its Neighbourhood Area Structure Plan (NASP) to the City, where it will be reviewed before it is shared publicly through a

City- led consultation process. There is a graphic posted on the West 240 website based on the submitted NASP. It shows vehicle access to/from West 240 will be off 122 St. only. However, the NASP is subject to City approval, so minimizing traffic impact remains a committee priority.
