Restrictive Covenant Info Session - GVH Hall on Wed., March 4, 7 p.m.

City Council recently voted to continue to allow 8-unit infill development with no on-site parking requirements. In response, a group of concerned GVH residents, led by Adil Ladak, is exploring the use of restrictive covenants as a tool to help influence future

development in GVH. Organizers see community-driven restrictive covenants as a pro-active tool to help protect property values and streetscapes from high density development.
