Survey on Genetic Testing for Autism

The University of Alberta's Precision Medicine in Autism (PRISMA) research group is currently conducting a research study about experiences and perspectives related to genetic testing for autism in Alberta. Their goal is to better understand people's knowledge and experiences with genetic testing, and to help identify ways to improve care and the healthcare system for autistic individuals and their families.

Participation involves completing an online survey that takes about 20 minutes, and some participants may also be invited to take part in an optional follow-up interview.
